- WHENEVER THE NATIONAL FLAG IS HOISTED OR LOWERED, WE MUST STAND AT ATTENTION AND SALUTE IT.
- IN A PROCESSION, THE FLAG MUST ALWAYSBE IN FRONT. A TORN FLAG SHOULD NOT BE HOISTED.
- WE SHOULD PRESERVE THE FLAG CAREFULLY




NATIONAL EMBLEM


